Merrill Gardens at Rancho Cucamonga



During the month of December, the Merrill Gardens at Rancho Cucamonga project saw noticeable progress on drywall and metal stud/soffit framing. The first level is ready to tape, texture and paint! The exterior continues to show great headway with the completion of vinyl window/door installation and stucco is gearing up for a big month. Site retaining walls have resumed on the south elevation of the project and we are scheduled to complete all retaining walls by the end of January!! Construction of this 112-unit project is expected to wrap up in August.

The exterior of the building has been changing colors with the completion of the building paper and sequencing cladding trades. On Desmond Street, the four townhouses are full steam ahead with structural framing following the completion of the steel moment frames. The framing is expected to wrap up in February following the delivery of roof trusses in late January. We are very excited to see these homes take shape! The Baxter on Broadway project is on schedule to finish construction this summer.
